It is hard to believe that we are going into our third month of the school year! The students and staff are very established in their routines. The students are fully engaged, learning many new things in the classroom. As I walk through the halls, I can hear Math, English, Science, and Social Studies being taught enthusiastically by our teachers. When I go to the gym, the students are changed, warming up and getting ready to begin a variety of drills and activities led by Mr. Nelson, our Physical Education teacher. These months have been full of action and excitement.

At MTMS this month we were able to achieve 97.05% attendance. We were able to beat our last months attendance and meet our goal of 97%! It is always important that all of the students, parents/guardians and the staff work together in order for this to happen. We thank you for your cooperation and we know our communication and trust will continue to grow stronger. In the Student Service area you will see an attendance wall created by Ms. Elias. She is also keeping the bus schedule up to date. We would like to thank Ms. Elias for doing both of these. Remember, the school has two buses with 51 students being picked up and dropped off every day. We know there are many situations that can arise that affect the bus schedule. Ms. Elias has changed the schedule more than 14 times since the beginning of the school year to accommodate all of the students needs at MTMS. We thank all the parents/guardians for their daily communication with the school and for their patience.

I would like to focus on the **Enrichment Programs** we offered after school in October. Our cooking class just wrapped up its eight week program. I would like to thank Paz for coordinating helpers and creating many tasty and beautiful dishes for our students. They were able to sample many new foods and took home recipes to share with their families. Mr. Bellavance was in charge of the Art Club and French Club on Mondays and Wednesdays. James Kleisinger ran the History Club every Thursday and he just finished an 8 week cycle. Mr. Nelson, our Computer and Physical Education teacher ran the Chess Club every Thursday. Ms. Scheuer, was in charge of Improv once a week. Regina Police Service Cadets is up and running every Tuesday after school. It is nice to see we have more than 20 students involved in this program. Last week, students went off school grounds to the Neil Balkwill Centre. Cadets plan to do a few more outings with the students before Christmas. Crystal Toth from the YMCA is doing Yoga for our students every Monday. This year, we developed a fitness room for the students at MTMS. The official name will be "Goals Gym!" Our new fitness equipment and programming will provide new opportunities for our students. Ms. Brundige and Mrs. Liebel are having a lot of fun with the girl's fitness program. I see many smiles in the room every time I walk by. I will be in charge of the boy's fitness training, but we just recently made contact with a personal trainer who is willing to take on the program after school. Wrestling is scheduled every Monday and I am having a wonderful time working with all the students involved.

November will include new after school programs such as: Babysitting for all grade 6 students, Origami, Film/Acting and Volleyball. Ms. Elias and Mr. Nelson are coaching the boys and girls volleyball teams. We have 21 girls and 8 boys participating in volleyball. We are proud to say this is the first volleyball team ever at MTMS. The dental, vision and hearing appointments were in full swing last month. We thank Dr. Lefebvre, our dentist, Dr. Monea, our optometrist, and Lisa Richardson, our audiologist for supporting our school every year. Their work never goes unnoticed. They play a huge part in minimizing health issues with our students.
