MTMS curriculum is enriched through extended school time, small class and school size, transitional supports and an innovative middle years program. This transformative model continually strives to engage students' intellectual curiosity, celebrate their culture and equip students to use their academic learning as a foothold for social and economic development. #### Mission

MTMS aims to break the cycle of poverty by providing an enhanced holistic Saskatchewan Ministry approved, faith-based middle school education to highly motivated, economically disadvantaged students from inner city Regina.

#### Vision

To graduate young men and women of character with intellect sufficient enough to ensure that they will become postsecondary graduates, and more importantly, they become role models and leaders in their communities.

MTMS is built on the Jesuit idea of *cura personalis,* which means care for the whole person. This includes tending to students' intellectual, social, physical, spiritual and emotional needs.

The nominal fee paid by families (\$50 monthly) and government support cover only 25% of what it costs to educate a middle school student annually. MTMS relies on the philanthropic support of many individuals, foundations and our community to meet our cost to educate and change the narrative for the MTMS Blues.

The three years at MTMS (from Grade 6 to Grade 8) sets the foundation; instilling a positive school experience and work and life habits, while providing the necessary supports to ensure students' overall well-being and success. MTMS programming provides an innovative and holistic approach to education. This progressive model involves tending to students' intellectual, social, physical, spiritual and emotional needs by providing extra supports, while removing barriers that hamper their success.
